Accordingly, the degree will be awarded over the course of six sessions on December 14th and 15th, 2023.

In order of the serial number assigned to them at 6.30 a.m., 11.30 a.m., and 3.00 p.m., respectively, the graduates who are expected to participate in the first to sixth sessions of the convocation should take up their positions in the graduation procession in front of the Rabindranath Tagore Memorial Auditorium.

Every graduand is allowed to bring a maximum of two visitors to the convocation. Graduation cloaks, garlands, graduation hats, and entry passes for the convocation will be issued to graduands at the Wellamadama complex of the University of Ruhuna on December 7th, 8th, and 9th, 2023 (for more information, please see Annex 1). **Please note that cloaks will not be issued on the day of convocation.**

An application can be used, and instructions for obtaining and returning cloaks, garlands, and graduation hats should be downloaded, and graduands are requested to strictly adhere to them.

Only graduates who have formal permission to attend the graduation ceremony will be allowed to attend, and anyone who fails to prove their identity with this letter will not be allowed to enter the graduation hall.

Graduand Buddhist monks will not be issued graduation cloaks or Vijinipath, as they will participate in the graduation procession without a graduation cloak or Vijinipath.

The male graduands are expected to present in either national dress or a full European suit, while the female graduands are expected to wear a colourful traditional *saree* or *osari* appropriate for the ceremonial atmosphere. **Latecomers will not be permitted to enter the convocation hall.**

Photography inside the convocation hall is totally prohibited, while cameras, photographic equipment, mobile phones, handbags, travel bags, parcels, etc. are not allowed to be taken into the convocation hall.

The university has arranged for professional photographers to make photos and videos of the conferment of the degree at the convocation, and those who wish to purchase photographs and videos of the event would be able to meet and discuss their needs with the authorised professional photographers at the Wellamadama Complex during the time of issuing cloaks.

You would be collected the degree certificate after the event on the same day of the convocation by the Examinations Branch of the University of Ruhuna (for more instructions, see Annex 02). To receive it, you are required to submit your student record book with the stamp on it that returns the cloak, garland, and hat.

While you are invited to participate in the convocation, it is appreciated that you extend your full cooperation to make the event a success.
