Topics

Talk about what makes someone a good friend. Describe the qualities you look for in a friend and give examples of things good friends do for each other.

5. Something I Am Good At:

Talk about a skill or activity you're good at, like drawing, playing a sport, solving puzzles, or telling jokes. Explain how you learned it and why you enjoy doing it.

1. Our Favourite Foods:

Talk about a place you enjoy visiting (e.g., a park, a library, a museum, a relative's house, a beach, a playground). Describe what it looks like and what you do there.

4. Things We Use Every Day:

Pick an everyday object you use (e.g., a pencil, a book, a backpack, a toy, a toothbrush, a phone, a ball). Talk about what it is, what it looks like, and how they use it.

5. Our Favourite Holidays/Celebrations:

Talk about a holiday or special celebration you enjoy (could be a family celebration, a national holiday, or a religious festival). Describe what people do during this celebration and why they like it.
